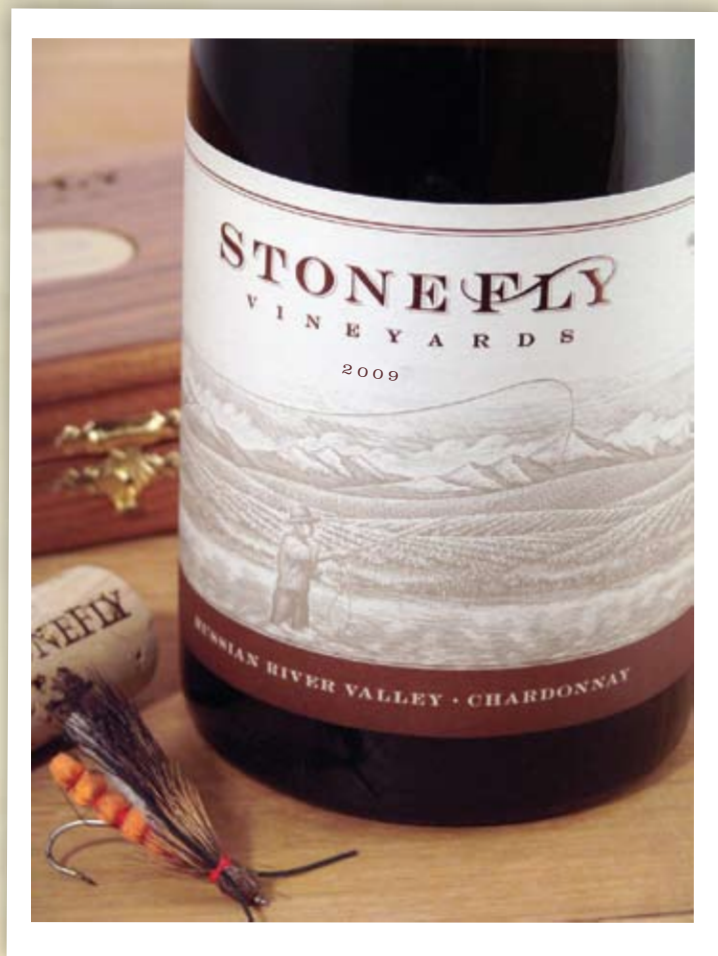

2009 CHARDONNAY Russian River Valley

The 2009 StoneFly Chardonnay is a rich, ripe wine from the cool climate Russian River Valley appellation. The use of stainless steel to ferment the majority of this wine results in a retention of the lively and delicate fruit character inherent in the grapes. The barrel fermented portion lends a great deal of complexity and structure to the finished wine.

The aromas and flavor are primarily fruit driven with hints of peach, white peach and apricot. Hints of honeysuckle and nutmeg spice add complexity and a long vanilla-apricot finish is irresistible. This wine would be a wonderful match with Caesar salad, garden fresh fingerling potatoes and the seasonal catch of the day.
